**Guided walks and talks at Rock Edge Nature Reserve and the Lye Valley examining the geology, flora and fauna of the ancient past (the Upper Jurassic 160 MYA) and then relating it to the present day topography and ecology.**

**Assemble at Rock Edge (SP 550 064/OX3 8NW) at 2pm for a geological explanation of Oxford's coral reef, and examine Corallian Jurassic fossils from this and other localities. Following a tour of the exposure we will walk over to the Lye Valley (SP 548 058/OX3 7HS) to examine a modern day alkaline fen ecosystem.**
